



## Memorandum of Understanding

Between

**NOMMENSEN HKBP University**

and

**Institute of Education & Teacher Center**

**National Taiwan Ocean University**



### 1. Preamble

In accordance with the mutual desire to foster cooperation between University of HKBP Nommensen and institute of Education & Teacher Center of Education, National Taiwan Ocean University in order to explore the potential for collaboration in the areas set out below, the two institutions have signed the following Memorandum of Understanding.

### 2. Areas for potential collaboration

Based on the principles of mutual benefit, both of institutions intend to explore opportunities for:

- (a) Promote Marine Education;
- (b) Movement of faculty, students ,scholars and staff between two institutions;
- (c) Hold a screening session ;
- (d) Research collaboration in the fields with mutual interest between research staff, and schools of both institutions;
- (e) Exchange and sharing of teaching and academic materials, publications, reference and other pertinent information;
- (f) All of the above with special reference to the cultural, economic, ethical, political and social implications of contemporary technology in the global context.

### 3. Implementation of Memorandum

Both institutions agree that specific projects and activities shall be developed for implementation of this Memorandum based on discussions and negotiations between two institutions. Agreements or contracts shall be signed separately to carry out these projects and activities.

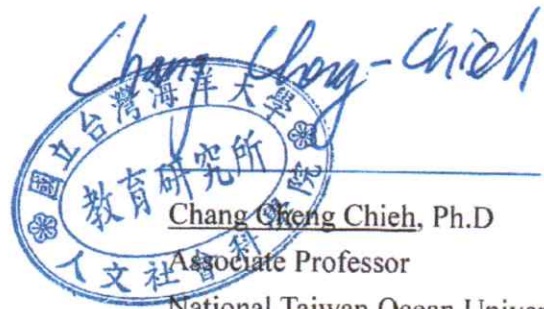
Both institutions agree that all financial arrangements shall be determined on the basis of specific projects and activities, and will depend on the availability of funds.

This Memorandum of understanding shall be in force for a period of 2 years from the date of its enactment. This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two institutions, and shall be renewed by mutual consent.

If this MOU is executed more than one language, the English version shall control in the event of inconsistency in meaning or interpretation of terms.
