



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Nommensen HKBP University
and
Chung Hua University**



1. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to promote the educational and academic cooperation between Nommensen HKBP University (herein referred to as NHU) and Chung Hua University (herein referred to as CHU). NHU and CHU agree to try their best to achieve the following objectives:
 - (1) Promoting institutional exchange by inviting faculty and staff to participate in joint research projects;
 - (2) Promoting the exchange of essays, publications, theses, and information related to the research;
 - (3) Promoting dual degree program;
 - (4) Promoting student exchange program.
2. In accordance with the principle of mutual and equal benefit, international travel costs will be borne by the visiting scholars (students), unless provided by specific arrangements.
3. Based on this MOU, NHU and CHU agree to assist each other in drawing up and carrying out the concrete contents of the research project if they develop various education plans in different areas. Details of these plans will be set up in a separate agreement to this memorandum.
4. The parties shall remain independent of one another and nothing herein shall be construed or interpreted, by implication or otherwise, to form a partnership, agency, joint venture or other formal business association.
5. The MOU shall be effective once it is signed by the official representatives of two institutes, and it shall be valid for five years, unless terminated by any party in the event of either party failing to perform or committing to breach of its obligations or undertakings under this MOU. Either party may terminate this MOU upon six months' written notice to the other party. However, the ongoing projects should be continued to the end and not be affected by the termination of the agreement.


